The French community of Grenoble Alpes Métropole – commonly known simply as the “the Metro” – is made up of 27 villages and is located at the crossroads of France, Switzerland and Italy, in the heart of Rhône-Alps, one of the most prosperous regions in Europe. The Metro brings together the resources of its member municipalities to plan, invest, develop and carry out major projects.

Grenoble Alpes Métropole uses BIRT in its Pilotage des actions application, for information, financial and schedule reporting. About 70 staff members – including financial and organizational staff – use the solution for strategic and operational reporting. BIRT has helped lead to more transparency within the Metro’s operations.
